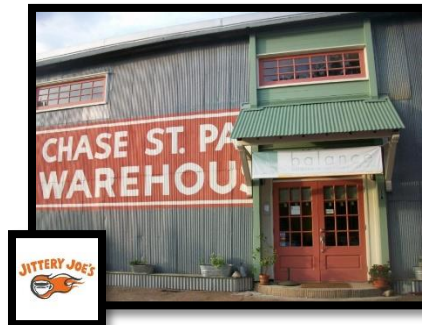

Sports Tour **Sanford Stadium**
