- We have been approached by several people about hosting the NAE4-HA meeting in 2021

- This would be a statewide effort
- The last time we hosted was in 2007 in Atlanta
- Royce- I was on the National Board when we selected Georgia in 2007. Very in depth process. I don't know that we would have the success that we did without the help from the other associations and retirees. It is a very intense undertaking if that is something that we plan to do. If we decide to do it, you need to clear your schedules. Things have to happen.
- Timothy Jennings- We had a lot of experience level with employees in 2007. Do we have that now?
- Al Parker- We didn't have a lot of people that had experience at a National meeting in 2007. Doing it now, we will have the experience of those that were here in 2007.
- Robbie- Starting in 2020, NAE4-HA will provide a conference planner which would be an advantage
- Kasey- Concern that we need to focus on making our association stronger before we host again. We would only have 10 month to get that together. We need to ask the membership. Put together a research package to present to membership in April.
- Brittani- We don't have to do this in 2021, we can do it in future years, but it would nice to have people who were around in 2007
- Abbie- If young professionals are going to be a part of it, we need to have them a part of it in the beginning. Include our entire membership
- Cheryl- Arch stated that the Georgia 4-H Foundation is willing to back us. He plans to be here through 2021 but that's not guaranteed. The Foundation will need to start putting money away if we are interested. We would need to give our membership an opportunity to do a payroll deduction

to assist with that. Members could pledge monthly or pledge a certain amount that is spread out over paychecks. As Royce stated, we will need to reach out to our other professional organizations.

- Jared- Who will be in the board positions? Who will be attending the NAE4-HA meetings so that they can get a good idea. Laura Perry Johnson would need to select the conference chairs and conference committee chairs.
- We need to have a discussion at the April GAE4-HA state meeting.
