

Dear Agribusiness/Producers,

As you are no doubt aware, crop damage caused by deer has been a problem in Bulloch County for a number of years. The problems, and the deer population, just keep on growing.

In order to help alleviate the problem, we have contacted the Georgia Wildlife Federation about a program called "Hunters for the Hungry". Under this program, hunters can kill deer and have them processed free of charge. The meat is then distributed to those in need.

We have secured participation from a local processor, Little Chicken Ranch, to handle the processing. Statesboro Food Bank will handle the distribution.

The Georgia Wildlife Federation has given us some seed money to start the program, but we do need additional funds to make the program successful. We are asking for \$100 minimum contributions or .10¢ per acre farmed.
