Using Pesticides Wisely 2026

Georgia State Specific Dicamba Training

1. As mandated by federal labels, **all applicators** must hold a private or commercial pesticide applicator license to purchase **and apply** the restricted-use herbicides Engenia, Stryax, and Tavium.
2. Prior to applying these products in Georgia during 2026, applicators must **complete the state-specific 2026 UPW classroom training** with locations provided below. Online training **WILL NOT** be available.
3. Those needing pesticide credits but not applying Engenia, Stryax, or Tavium are welcome to attend.
4. Bring your pesticide license; **2 hours** of pesticide credits for private or commercial will be provided.
5. The meeting will last about 1.5 hours; **NO** beverages or meals will be provided.
6. Attendees' names will be placed on a list posted to the Georgia Department of Agriculture's auxin website at <https://agr.georgia.gov/dicamba>.

Topics discussed: Pesticide applicator safety, new dicamba label changes, required recordkeeping/documentation when applying these herbicides, and fulfilling the new Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements, along with other valuable information.
