- 1. Supply Grab-n-Go Cooler with community garden
- 2. Formalize communication practices to advertise resources to the community.
- 3. Find an alternate location for the Lumpkin City Hall Grab-n-Go Cooler to a space where more community members frequent, not just staff in city
- 4. Increase recruitment efforts with non-involved community groups.
- 5. Find funding opportunities for future of the
