## BEETS

## WHEN TO HARVEST

- Harvest beet roots when they are 1½ to 2 inches in diameter.
- Tender greens (once they reach 6 to 8 inches long) may be harvested and eaten.
- Beets planted in the fall should be harvested before the first moderate freeze







snuggly, and pull the beet out of the ground.

Dust off any soil on the root. Do not wash the roots until you are ready to use them, because the excess moisture can cause premature rotting.

## **STORAGE**

Unwashed beets can be stored in perforated plastic bags in the refrigerator for up to 2 weeks.
