CARROTS

WHEN TO HARVEST

- Carrots are ready to harvest when their tops are at least 1 inch in diameter.
- The very tops of the carrots will likely start to pop out of the soil & their orange color will be vibrant.
- Baby carrots will be ready to harvest earlier than mature carrots.







Loosen the soil surrounding the carrot top with a garden fork before pulling the carrot out of the ground.

Grab the foliage of the carrot close to the base and gently pull the entire carrot out of the ground.

STORAGE

Cut off the carrot tops and store them in cold, moist conditions. Carrots' expected self life is eight months.
