KALE

WHEN TO HARVEST

- Kale is a hearty plant best harvested in the late fall, even after a frost.
- Kale is ready to harvest when the leaves are about the size of your hand.
- There are many varieties and colors of Kale so be sure to check the specific species planted in your garden.



HOW TO HARVEST



Kale is easiest to harvest using garden scissors. Cut off the outer leaves near the base.

Pick about a fistful of outer leaves per harvest, but no more than one-third of the plant at one time.

Avoid harvesting the smaller, innermost leaves. Leave those so the plant can grow again next season.

STORAGE

Store kale like other leafy greens, in a loose plastic bag in the refrigerator. It should keep for about 1 week.
