LETTUCE

WHEN TO HARVEST

- Lettuce has a wide window of growing maturity, so be sure to check your seed packet to know when it should be ready.
- Head lettuce (like Romaine) is ready to harvest when the head is firm to the touch.
- Loose leaf lettuce is ready when the leaves are approximately 6 inches long.



HOW TO HARVEST



- Both loose leaf and head lettuce is best harvested using a pair of garden scissors.
- Snip the lettuce near the base of the plant (loose leaf example in the left photo).

STORAGE

Store unwashed lettuce leaves in the fridge. Wash lettuce leaves using a colander and dry the leaves well before consuming.
