

T U R N I P S

WHEN TO HARVEST

1

Turnips come in many varieties that can be harvested at various points.

2

Check your seed packet for exact harvest timelines, but once the turnips reach 2 inches in diameter they are ready.

3

Turnips should be harvested before the first freeze of the season.



HOW TO HARVEST

1

Use a garden shovel or hand fork to loosen the soil around the turnip. It is best for the soil to be dry.

2

Gently pull the turnip from the soil by gripping the base of the green just above the soil.



STORAGE

Remove the greens and the bottom roots from the turnips and store them in the fridge. They can last up to 4 months.
