- NAE4-HA Name Change Sonya Jones
 - National association name change was voted on and officially approved at annual meeting; the official name is now National Association of Extension 4-H Youth Development Professionals (NAE4-HYDP)
 - According to state association bylaws, if we are changing our state association name, it must be announced at least 20 days prior to a vote. Therefore, proposal for name change should be ready by the end of the JCEP meeting in March.
 - Kevin Tatum made a motion to table the proposal until the March JCEP meeting. Rebekah Greene seconded. Motion passed
