November 19, 2021
Minutes

Call to order: The meeting was called to order by ANREP President Bryan Fluech.

Minutes: Minutes from the virtual annual business meeting were reviewed and approved by Board of Directors.

Financial Update: Kim Toal, ANREP Treasurer, shared information concerning 2022 membership drive. Members can choose to join online (using credit card to pay fees) and then national ANREP sends check to state chapter for dues. (If you do this, please let Kim know so she can expect your payment.) You can also print forms and pay via check (mailed directly to Kim's office.) Active member is \$100 - \$75 national dues and \$25 state dues. If you pay online, there is a \$3 convenience fee.

Website: Kasey Bozeman, State Staff Representative, shared ideas about website updates.
