Okefenokee Swamp Guided Boat Tour Tuesday, May 21 (1pm) in Folkston (extra \$30)

Pre-registered is required. Our guided boat tour will travel along the historic Suwannee Canal through a tangled forest of bay, cypress, pine and shrubs, then out into the open expanse of Chesser Prairie. Guides will share their knowledge of the swamp's cultural and natural history, tell interesting swamp stories and identify plants and wildlife along the way. Wildlife activity varies with water levels, season, time of day and reasons known only to the wildlife. Participants will meet at Okefenokee Adventures (inside the Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge's main entrance at 4159 Suwannee Canal Road; Folkston, GA 31537).
