

Youth attending the 2022 Mission Make-It event are encouraged to bring a decorated agricultural product to the art show!

The guidelines below mirror the 2022 Georgia National Fair rules, so work with your local UGA Extension/4-H Office to be sure your art is also entered in the Georgia National Fair later this year!

- Entries should be in one of three categories: (1) animals, (2) seasonal holidays, or (3) other.
- Dried, non-perishable agricultural products (such as gourds, dried corn, peanuts, etc.) must be used and may be penetrated (with pins, earrings, etc.).
- Fresh vegetables and agricultural products which may spoil may not be used.
- No artificial agricultural products may be used.
- Exhibits must be no larger than 24" in any direction.
- No perishable items may be used as decoration for the exhibit.
- 4-H'er must provide a 3 x 5 index card with a list of supplies used.
- Exhibits will be judged on originality (25 pts), overall appearance (25 pts), and adherence to rules (50 pts).



Winners in each division will be recognized at the closing assembly during the 2022 Mission Make-It event.
