Application Scoring Rubric

The Georgia 4-H Mission Make-It program accepts applications for high school youth (9th-12th grade) to serve as Teen Leaders during the event. Teen Leaders are paired with adult leaders and co-lead two educational workshops. Additionally, they are required to bring a STEM-related educational exhibit to display. Teen leaders must complete the Georgia 4-H Certified Teen Leader training prior to the event. Each application is reviewed by a team of adult leaders using the criteria below. The 4-H'ers basic identifying information (name, county, etc.) will be withheld on the reviewer's application packet. Therefore, the reviewer will not know the name of the 4-H member they are evaluating.
