

# National 4-H Shooting Sports Quiz Bowl - 2024

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

# What does it cost to participate in the Quiz Bowl?

\$10 per entry, or \$40 for a team of 3 or 4 youth

#### What are the age divisions?

Juniors are 9-11 on January 1, 2024 Intermediates are 12-14 on January 1, 2024 Seniors are 15-19 on January 1, 2024

#### Can kids of mixed ages compete together on a team?

Yes, you can put younger and older kids together on one team, but you must choose the division of the oldest child. For example, two seniors and an intermediate must be on a senior team. Team members are automatically scored as individuals and will receive individual as well as team recognition in their appropriate division according to their age.

#### Is this for Shooting Sports kids only?

No, the quiz is open to all, however kids involved in shooting sports will likely be more knowledgeable about the answers. However, all the information is taken from the study materials provided.

#### Is it discipline specific, or general knowledge?

The Quiz Bowl is comprehensive, including disciplines from ALL 4-H Shooting Sports disciplines (Archery, Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun, Muzzle Loading, Hunting Skill and Western Heritage) as well as general 4-H knowledge and STEM.

# Is there a specific time that kids have to participate/sign on to take the quiz?

The Quiz Bowl is a virtual event. Upon registration you will receive a one-time link to the quiz. You can take the quiz anytime between 12:01AM (EST) on Monday, January 15, 2024 and 11:59PM (EST) on Friday, January 19, 2024 – there will be no late entries or retakes. The time alloted for the quiz is 30-minutes for juniors and 60-minutes for intermediate and seniors. Most finish before the alloted time.

#### How is the quiz scored?

Juniors will have 25 questions Seniors will have 50 questions Scores are based on

- number of correct answers
- time it takes to complete the quiz
- The remaining time upon completion of the test (Juniors are given 30 minutes, Intermediate and Seniors 60 minutes if you go over time the quiz will not shut off, you just won't get any bonus time.

Teams scores will consist of the top 3 scores, with the 4<sup>th</sup> score being thrown out. If a team only has three teammates then those scores will be used.

### Are there awards?

Yes, top 10 regional teams and individuals, as well as the top 10 national teams and individuals, will be awarded medallions or ribbons.
