Payment by cash or check **MUST** accompany orders. Plants will be available for pick-up on March 3rd from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. at the Tattnall County High School Livestock Barn. Some plants are over 3' high, so we recommend pick-up in a truck if you have trees in your order. Payment accepted by cash or check (Made payable to Tattnall County Ext.\4-H). If special arrangements are needed for pick-up, they must be pre-scheduled with the Extension staff. **No refunds will be given for plants that are not picked up on the assigned pick-up date.** For more information, call (912) 557-6724.
